EACH SQUARE 5' X 5'

SUNRISE COURT

TOTAL AREA PRESENTLY UNDER TURF IRRIGATION IS 3800 S.F. REDUCED BY 2271 SF WITH THE PATHS AND PLANTING BEDS.

REMOVE CENTRAL SAND AREA AND MOVE PICNIC TABLE AND BOULDER TO PERIMETER TO PROVIDE A CENTRAL GREEN.

STONE BENCH AND STONE PATIO TWO LARGE BOULDERS, 14-18" IN HEIGHT AND 3'-4" IN DIAMETER AT EACH CORNER. SMOOTH RIVER BOULDERS SHOULD BE USED TO BE THE LEAST ABRASIVE

GRAVEL PATHWAYS ARE MORE THAN WALKWAYS THEY ARE ALSO LOW MAINTENANCE VISUAL ELEMENTS

BOULDERS ARE ADDED TO THE LANDSCAPE FOR VISUAL INTEREST

THE INTERIOR OF THE SPACE REMAINS AS A GREEN, THE PERIMETER IS TAKEN OUT OF LAWN AND REPLACED WITH SHRUBS, AND UNDERSTORY TREES.

SHRUBS AND TREE WHEN PLANTED AT A SMALLER SIZE OFTEN EXCEED LARGER PLANTS DURING INITIAL PLANTING. AREAS OF SPACE BETWEEN THE BOULDERS, ALSO LOW MAINTENANCE WHICH WILL ALLOW FOR AN OPEN BEAUTIFUL LANDSCAPE

TWO THIRDS OF THE BEDS IN LARGE COBBLES PLANTS MULCHED WITH RED WOOD MULCH, LASTS THE LONGEST IN THE LANDSCAPE, FROM FARM RAISED TREES. THIS WILL ALSO BE USED AROUND THE BASE OF SHRUBS AND TREE TRUNKS.

EXISTING PLANTERS TO BE ADDED TO WITH APPROPRIATE SHRUBS AND GRASSES.

USE A HIGH QUALITY STEEL EDGING OVER 5 OZ LANDSCAPE WEED BARRIER CLOTH

TAKE AREAS UNDER THE TREES CANOPY IN MOST LOCATIONS RELY ON THE TREE TRUNKS AND BOULDERS TO ADD INTEREST. USE CITY TO MULCH UNDER TREES, MAINTAIN MULCH BY TOP DRESSING IT BI ANNUALLY

REMOVE EXISTING PLAY AREA TIMBERS. INSPECT FOR WEAR AND IF USEABLE FOR SOME OTHER USEFUL PURPOSE. THE TIMBERS IF NOT ROTTED ARE TREATED, PROBABLY WITH A CURRENTLY BANNED TREATMENT WOULD NOT BE GOOD FOR VEGETABLES. I IMAGINE ANY FREE RADICALS FROM THE TREATMENT HAVE DISAPPEARED AND WOULD NOT BE TERRIBLY HARMFUL TO THE ENVIRONMENT AND COULD BE USED TO STABILIZE THE BRIDGE AT 28TH NEAR WHERE THE SOIL HAS BEEN LOST UNDER THE SIDEWALK.

SAND IS NOT ALL THAT USEFUL IT CAN GERMINATE SEEDS IF IT IS USED IN THE PATHWAYS AS PART OF THE GRAVEL MIX. WITH OUR CLAY BASED SOIL IF WE MIX THAT WITH SAND WE GET ADOBE. SO MAYBE THE SAND COULD BE USED FOR DRAINAGE UNDER THE TOP SOIL IN THE VEGETABLE GARDENS, OR FOR WINTER TRACTION ON ICE.
